Public Utilities Commission (PUC)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 19(12) of the Belize Telecommunications Act, No. 16 of 2002, and Section 11(3) of the Telecommunications (Licensing Classification, Authorization, and Fee Structure) Regulations, 2002, and all other powers thereunto enabling, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC; the Commission) serves Notice this day, November 30, 2010, that effective January 1, 2011, it intends to revoke the Internet Service Provider (ISP) class licenses granted to the following license holders:

- b) UTECH
- c) Wireless Internet Solutions (Pier 1)
- d) IPO Networks Limited
- e) Mirrornet Limited
- f) International Technologies Limited

Reasons for Intended License Revocations:

The Commission intends to revoke the ISP Class Licenses granted to the above license holders for failure to pay the required approval fees associated with the granting of their licenses, failure to provide the services required by their respective licenses, and/or failure to submit required annual returns with respect to their licensed businesses.

Where any of the above license holders remedies the breaches referred to immediately above within thirty (30) days commencing with the date of this Notice and to the satisfaction of the Commission, the Commission shall withdraw its proposal to revoke the respective license.
